Senior Citizens Benefits

The Board of Education recognizes the contribution senior citizens have made to the support of education and wishes to encourage their continued support and participation in school sponsored events.

To this end, the Board of Education offers to any senior citizen 62 years of age or older a 50% discount on the admission to any school sponsored athletic function. At the age of 65, senior citizens will be admitted to these events free of charge. The Superintendent shall establish procedures for issuing identification cards to eligible resident senior citizens.

The Board of Education also encourages booster organizations and parent groups which sponsor school events to offer discounts to senior citizens whenever possible.
