Instruction

Homebound Instruction

The Board of Education recognizes the need to ensure the continuity of instruction when a student is unable to attend school for a medical or behavioral health reason for more than ten (10) consecutive school days. The PPT or 504 Team, as appropriate, will consider the written recommendation of a licensed physician or psychiatrist.

In order to accomplish this, the Board will provide homebound and hospital instruction.

Home instruction may also be provided for those students who have been excluded from regular school attendance for disciplinary reasons for more than ten (10) consecutive days.
